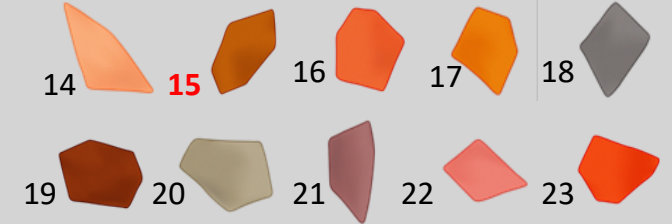

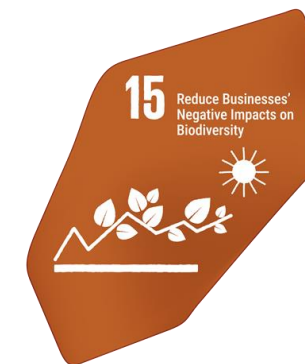

Regularly Monitor, assess, and disclose risks, dependencies and impacts on biodiversity



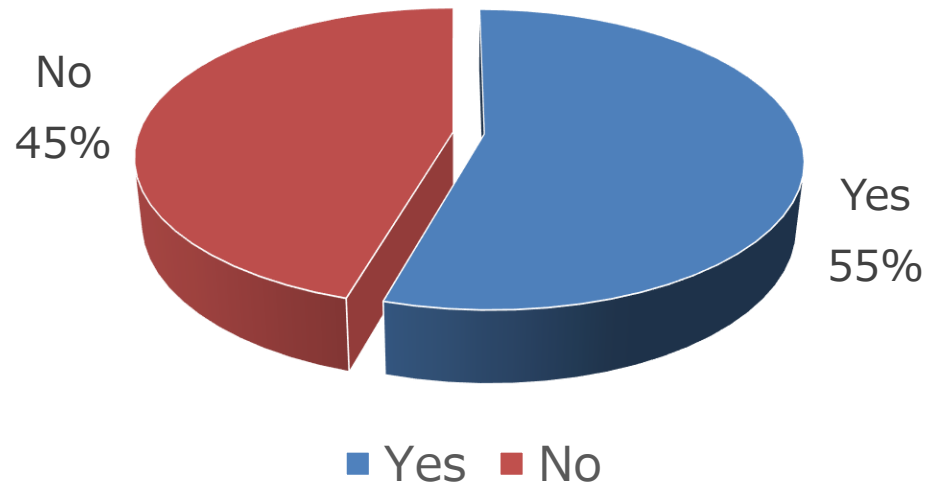
Progressively negative impacts on biodiversity reduced

Progressively positive impacts increased



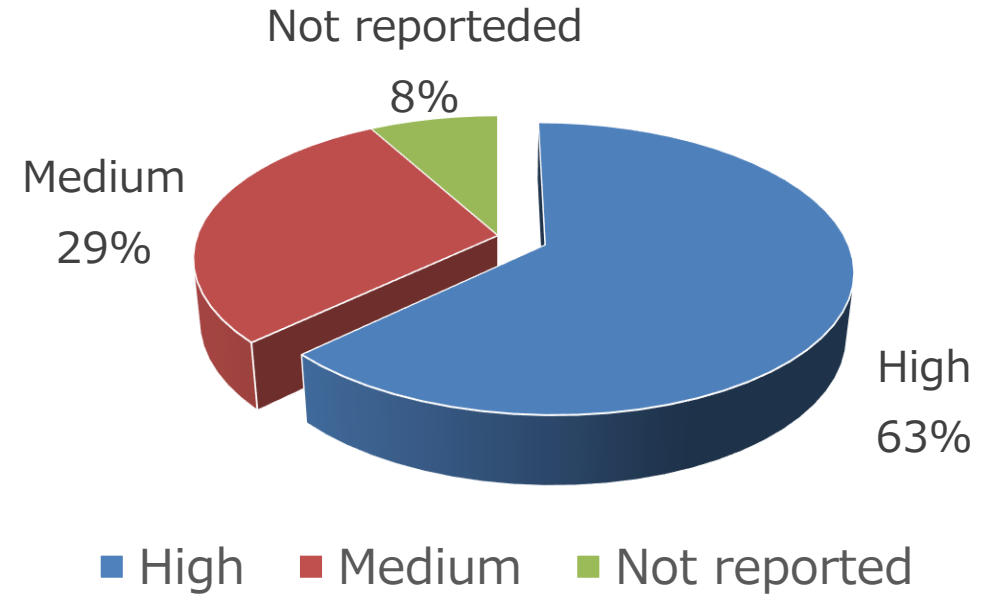
# Global Trends in National Targets and Global Report
